

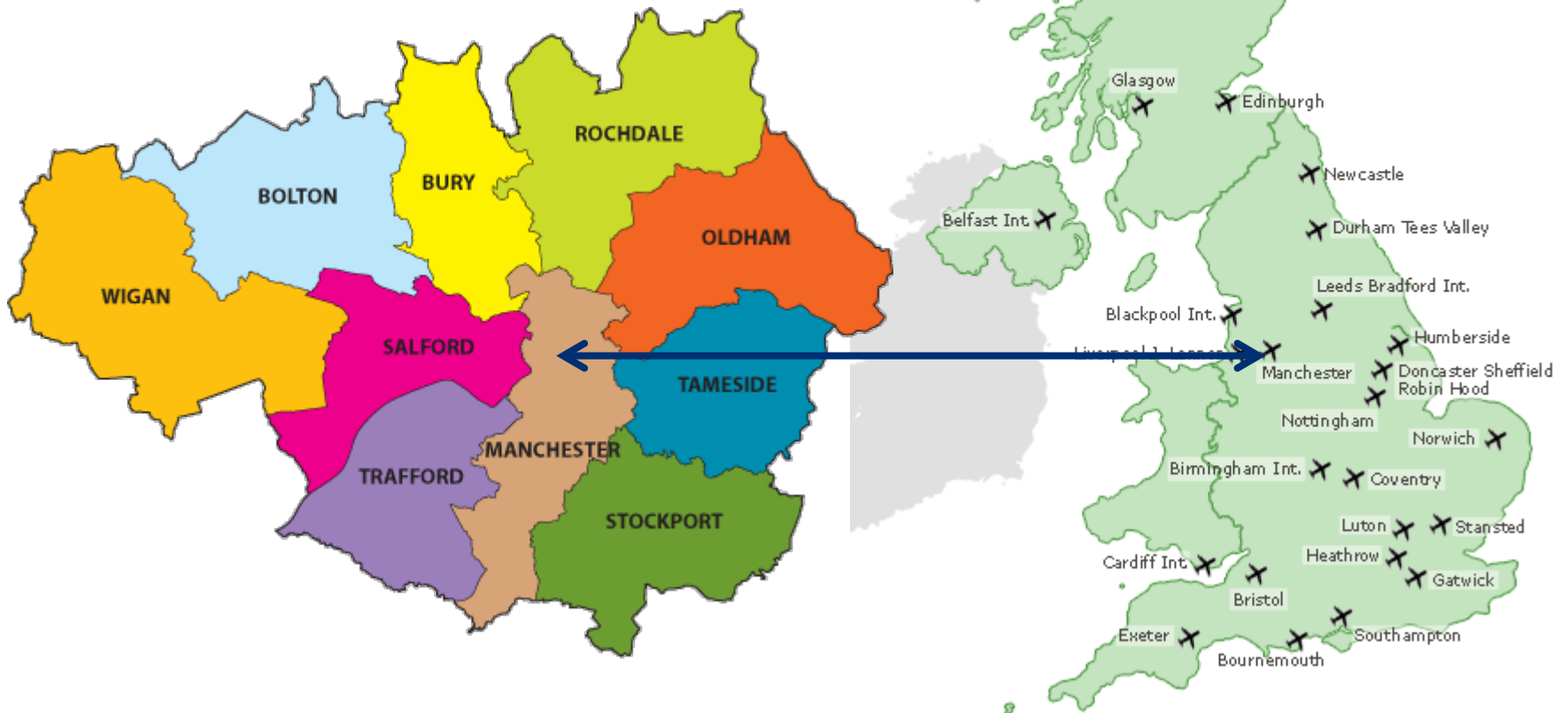
Heraldic Shield (Coat of Arms)

- The Red rose represents Lancashire

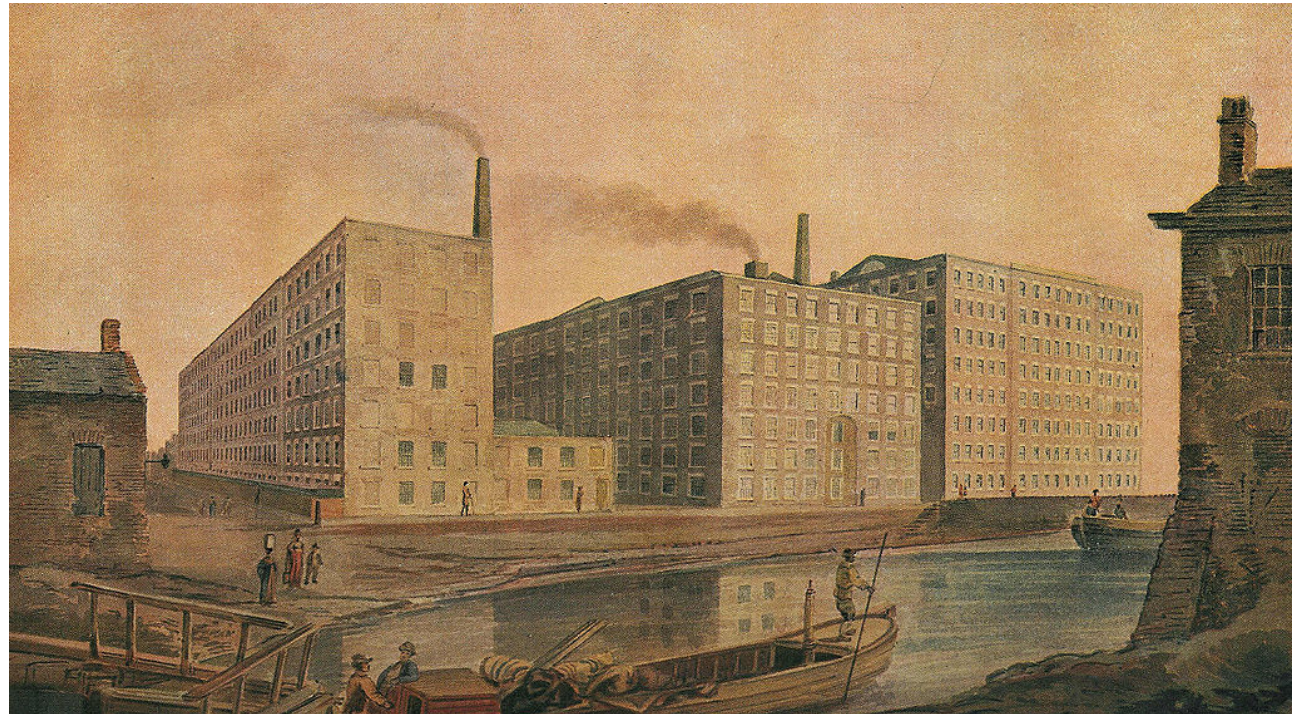
Greater Manchester
